Eligibility requirements:

- 1. Applicants must be students age 29 or under, Canadian citizens/residents with a permanent address in the Cowichan Valley, who are a) currently pursuing, or b) 2014 graduates who expect to pursue post-secondary studies in one of the following areas, all of which were close to David Walden's heart: piano performance, piano accompaniment, organ, classical voice, musical theatre, composition/improvisation, classical guitar, and all orchestral instruments.
- 2. The applicant must be: a) a Grade 12 student of, or b) a post-secondary student nominated by, a current CVMTA member. (CVMTA Membership is open to all Cowichan Valley music teachers; yearly dues are \$65. Please email Ann Mendenhall at am-pm@shaw.ca for more information.)
- 3. The competition for the 2014 Scholarship will be held the evening of May 30, 2014 at St. Peter Quamichan church hall. For all categories except composition/improvisation, two contrasting pieces/songs should be performed; total audition time should not exceed 15 minutes. Accompanists must provide their own soloist(s). Composition students must submit original score(s) and recording(s) along with their application; they are also expected to attend the audition and may be asked to improvise.
- 4. Applicants may compete in more than one category.
- 5. Applicants will be notified no later than May 30, 2014.
- 6. Applicants must submit this completed form, along with supporting documents, and the \$20 application fee (\$15 for each additional category),* on or before April 5, 2014, to: Ann Mendenhall, CVMTA President, 3790 Glenora Road, Duncan, BC, V9L 6S5
